FASTER FOOTBALL RETURNS TO SINGAPORE

Three-day festival of short-form football confirmed for July 2026

Elite football clubs from Europe, Asia, and South America will go head-to-head in fast-paced 7-a-side games in Singapore from Friday 24 to Sunday 26 July 2026.

***Faster Football* will return to the region for the first in a series of major events planned for Asia and MENA, featuring clubs from leagues including the English Premier League, Bundesliga, Campeonato Brasileiro, Serie A, Chinese Super League and Liga Super Malaysia.**

The 3-day tournament, on the full-size artificial turf at *Our Tampines Hub*, will bring:

- **Elite football - 36 clubs from across the globe, with world famous clubs and the region's biggest teams playing across men's, women's and masters tournaments.**
- **Non-stop action - 7-a-side football, 7-minute halves on a full size pitch, with over 350 players competing in 95 matches over the three-day weekend.**
- **Festival setup - meet & greets with players, a mass participation event with local teams, plus food, drink and entertainment in a celebration of local culture.**

Confirming the event in 2026, Faster Football CEO Dom Lane said:

"It's kick-off for the next phase of *Faster Football*, as we prepare to expand across Asia and the Middle East.

"This is authentic, all-action football, where European and South American powerhouses face the biggest names from the region. It's 7-a-side, 7-minute halves, on full-size pitches, with 95 fast-paced matches over a fun-packed, sun-drenched three-day weekend.

“Quite simply, it’s quality players on quality pitches with a quality experience for players, fans and commercial partners. And Singapore is the perfect place to return; an iconic city, a great hub for travel and the perfect venue to build on last year’s success.”

Launched in July 2025 at Singapore’s Jalan Besar Stadium, under the banner of the *Soccer7sSeries*, the first event featured 36 iconic clubs - including Borussia Dortmund, Corinthians, Leicester City, Shanghai Shenhua, PERSIB, Coventry City, QPR and Hashtag United - across men’s, women’s and masters teams.

It was broadcast globally with; over 30 hours of live coverage across over 200 territories through DAZN, co-streamers and competing club’s digital channels, and over 2.5million YouTube livestream viewers. The event also attracted 90 million social views and 200,000 new subscribers and followers to Faster Football’s channels.

James Hopkins, Head of Broadcast for *Faster Football*, added:

“We’ve some exciting deals in the pipeline, including with broadcasters in Europe, China, the Middle East and across Asia. And we’ve strong experience, great data and insight, and real proof of delivery to build on.

“In everything we do, *Faster Football* offers real entertainment, strong fan engagement and the very best value for partners. Our content - both distributed and co-created - simply shows great football and showcases local energy, making the most of both local connections and global reach.”

Teams for this year’s *Faster Football* event in *Singapore* will be announced in due course with details on ticket packages to follow.

On playing in the 7-a-side format, Wes Morgan, a winner with Leicester City at last year’s event in Singapore and captain of their English Premier League-winning team, said:

“Singapore, last year, was a great location and experience. The players were buzzing to travel, meet up again and do what we love - playing good, competitive football. The 7-a-side format is really enjoyable. It’s important to be brave at the back, comfortable one-on-one and ready to adapt. We had defenders getting up front, strikers dropping into midfield and everyone was flexible, looking to create chances and wanting to win.”
